There are a few important updates that we would like you to bring to your attention.

### **Diabetes Walk**

Tomorrow, Saturday, there will be a fundraising walk for Diabetes that starts right in front of the community at 6<sup>th</sup> and Laurel. They are expecting about 3,500 people which is a smaller than usual crowd from about 6:00 am to 10:30 am. All roads will be open. However, there will be one of the two northbound lanes on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue that will be closed for the walk. All lanes will be reopened by 10:00 am.

### **Garage Waterproofing Project**

Over the next five weeks, we are making repairs to the waterproofing in the garage.

From Monday, November 13<sup>th</sup> through Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, the EXIT ramp will be closed.

From Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup> through Monday, November 27<sup>th</sup>, the ENTRY ramp will be closed.

During these times, you will need to use the alternate ramp. As in the past, the cars pulling into the garage, have the right of way since it is more difficult to back up and maneuver.

We appreciate your patience and understanding, while we restore the waterproofing on these ramps.
