

Dear Resident,

We hope you had a wonderful week! A very special thank you to the Social Committee including Marjorie O'Malley, Lezli Rogers, Harriet Kounaves, Teresa Lewis, and Judi Gottschalk. The parties are always an excellent opportunity to catch up with friends around the community and meet new residents.

A few very important updates before we embark on the weekend.

The garage project is going incredibly well, and all of the areas that had minor leaks are being corrected. It is normal for a building to do routine injections in the garage walls.

Next week, we will be working on the *underside* of the entry ramp. The entry ramp has leaks that need to be injected from right below. The area right below is the ramp from P1 to P2.

Therefore, we will have the following closures next week;

- The ramp from P1 to P2 – Closed Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 8:30 am to 4:00 PM. During this time, two-way traffic will be in effect on the up ramp from P2 to P1. Also, please note that if you are going to P2, you will need to drive around through the South Tower to the designated ramp.
- Parking spaces 242-249 will be unavailable. Please utilize your tandem space next week.

The week of December 18th through December 23rd, we will be closing the entry ramp to re-coat the top of the ramp.

AT&T Installations

The installation of AT&T wiring is also going very well. The crews are ahead of schedule and completed all of the North Tower this week. Next week, AT&T will be pulling the wire into all the units in the South Tower. Here is an estimate of where we will be each day;

- Monday – PH through 11
- Tuesday – 10 through 7
- Wednesday – 6 through 3
- Thursday – 2nd Floor and townhomes

The schedule is subject to change, but based on the progress this week, we feel this would be the schedule for the South Tower. We will call with updates the day before. Jeremy is escorting the AT&T technicians into the Laundry Rooms of each unit every day. You do not need to be home, and we will only be accessing the Laundry Rooms.

The AT&T service will be live here in our community in March or April. This is the first of three installations necessary to bring you the service.
