Here are a few items that we would like to make you aware of.

**Race for Autism**

**Balcony Painting**

The balcony painting will start on Monday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. We will begin with the 01 stack and move our way to the 02, 03 and 04 stacks in the North Tower. The painters will complete one balcony per day. A schedule will be provided by next week.

**Specialty Recycling**

Remember that you can drop-off any electronic recycling such as TVs, computers, laptops, printers, calculators or anything with a chip at the Concierge Desk. We collect them year around and will take them to the recycling centers periodically throughout the year.

In addition, you may drop off unused paint by leaving it in one of the trash rooms on P1. If the paint inside the can has hardened, you may dispose of it in the trash dumpster. If it is still in liquid form, we have to recycle it at the local paint store.

As always, batteries and ink cartridges can be left with the Concierge for recycling.
